Directions

The fairgrounds are located at the intersection of Route 71 and East Highpoint Road, just 1 mile west of Route 47 in Yorkville, Illinois. Several state highways come through Yorkville including Route 47, Route 34 (Ogden Avenue), Route 126 and Route 171. The main entrance into the fairgrounds is on Highpoint Road.

From I-88 coming from the northwest or northeast:

Take the Sugar Grove exit onto Route 47 and travel south through Yorkville. Route 71 crosses Route 47 about 1 1/2 miles south of Yorkville. Turn west to the fairgrounds.

From I-80 coming from the south:

Exit onto Route 47 in Morris and travel north to the Route 71 intersection. Turn west to the fairgrounds.
